



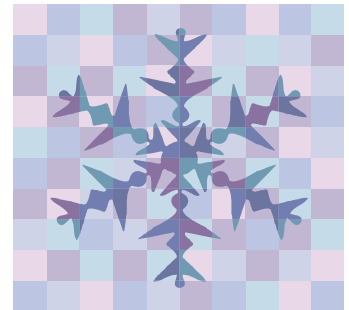

May 8-12, 2006, Wichita, Kansas

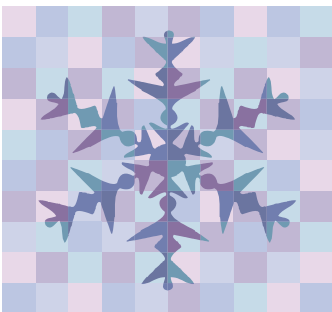
